Amend the amendment by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the emergency clause the following:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7451, sub-§2, ¶F is enacted to read:

F. All bear presented for registration shall be field dressed in a manner that permits determination of the sex of the animal.

Further amend Part B by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

Statement of Fact

Presently some bear hunters are field dressing bear in such a way that the sex of the bear cannot be determined when the bear is presented for registration. This amendment would require that the bear be dressed in a manner which permits the sex of the bear to be determined.
