HOUSE AMENDMENT "F" to SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 649,
L.D. 1677, Bill, "AN ACT to Make Corrections of Errors and
Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the amendment by inserting at the end before the
statement of fact the following:

'Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before
the emergency clause the following:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7451, sub-§2, ¶F is enacted to read:
F. All bear presented for registration shall be field
dressed in a manner that permits determination of the
sex of the animal.

Further amend Part B by renumbering the sections to read
consecutively.

Statement of Fact

Presently some bear hunters are field dressing bear in such
a way that the sex of the bear cannot be determined when the
bear is presented for registration. This amendment would
require that the bear be dressed in a manner which permits the
sex of the bear to be determined.
