SENATE AMENDMENT "F" to SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 649,  
L.D. 1677, Bill, "AN ACT to Make Corrections of Errors and  
Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the amendment by inserting at the end before the  
statement of fact the following:

'Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before  
the emergency clause the following:

Sec. 1. P&SL 1981, c.49 is amended to read:

Program for practical nursing. The Eastern Maine ~~Vocational-~~  
~~Technical~~/Institute may operate a program for practical nursing in  
the → City of Ellsworth. The program established shall not be  
funded from the General Fund but shall be funded for the first year  
of the biennium from dedicated revenues derived from other sources  
and retained in a special revenue account hereby authorized for that  
purpose.

Sec. 1-A. Effective date. The amendment to Private and Special  
Law 1981, c. 49 contained in Part B of this Act shall take effect  
90 days after adjournment of the Legislature.'

Further amend Part B by renumbering the sections to read  
consecutively.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to enable use of private funds to establish the nursing school. Without this amendment, any funds contributed must be paid to the General Fund. For the first year of the biennium, authority is needed to dedicate all private funds made available for this program to a special revenue account to carry out the purpose of this legislation.
