HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 654, L.D. 1679, Bill, "AN ACT  
to Remove the Customer Charge from Electric Utility Rate Structures."

Amend the bill in that part designated "§96." by striking  
out all of subsection 4 and inserting in its place the following:

'4. Residential customers engaged in agriculture. Any  
increase in the per kilowatt-hour charge resulting solely from  
this section des not apply to residential customers for agricultural  
purposes as defined in Title 36, section 2013, subsection 1,  
paragraph A.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment removes family farmers from the impact of  
the legislation in a simpler way than the bill does.
