HOUSE AMENDMENT " $\mathcal{B}$ " to H.P. 1589, L.D. 1680, Bill, "AN ACT to Maintain and Improve Marine Patrol Services."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the end before the fiscal note the following:

'Sec. 17. Repeal. This Act shall be repealed January 1, 1982, unless the Commissioner of Marine Resources has demonstrated to the Legislature, prior to this date, that the Bigelow Laboratory for Ocean Sciences will pay to the Department of Marine Resources, for lease of property and buildings located at McKown Point, Boothbay Harbor, Maine, a fee of at least \$50,000 for fiscal year 1982 and at least \$62,000 for fiscal year 1983.'

## Statement of Fact

The Department of Marine Resources is recently negotiating with the Bigelow Laboratory for Ocean Sciences a long-term lease for valuable laboratory facilities and land at McKown Point, Boothbay Harbor. Bigelow Laboratory is not paying the State anything for this lease, in spite of the fact that the Department of Marine Resources is hard pressed financially.
