SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 666, L.D. 1686, Bill, "AN ACT Making Supplemental Appropriations from the General Fund for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1981, June 30, 1982, and June 30, 1983."

Amend the bill in Part A, under the caption "DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL SERVICES" by inserting after the part designated "Historic Preservation Commission" the following:

'Library Development Services		
Personal Services	70,000	70,000
All Other	15,000	15,000

Funds are included to reinstate 2 existing bookmobile routes: \$85,000 for East Machias and \$85,000 for Houlton, both funded for the biennium.'

Further amend the bill in Part A, under the caption "DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL SERVICES" by striking out all of the last line and inserting in its place the following:

'Total Current Services	\$518,573	\$798,125'

Further amend the bill in Part A by striking out all of the last line (last 2 lines in LD) and inserting in its place the following:

'TOTAL CURRENT SERVICES - PART A	\$11,144,686	\$15,542,048'
