HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1625, L.D. 1687, Bill,
"AN ACT Concerning Homestead Tax Relief."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§6197." in
subsection 3 by striking out all of the question and inserting
in its place the following: "Shall homestead tax relief be
available to persons, residing in (name of municipality), 70
years or older, under the Revised Statutes, Title 36, chapter 909?"
