SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 701, L.D. 1692, Bill, "AN ACT to Make Additional Corrections of Errors and Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the bill by striking out all of the last paragraph before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, sections 2, 3 and 4 of this Act shall take effect when approved.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to make sections 3 and 4 emergency measures, correcting an omission in the original bill.
