SENATE AMENDMENT " B " to H.P. 1716, L.D. 1703, Bill, "AN  
ACT Providing for Conformity with the United States Internal  
Revenue Code as of December 1, 1981."

Amend the Bill in the 2nd line after the amending clause  
(first and 2nd lines in L.D.) by striking out the following:  
"but on or before December 31, 1981,"

Fiscal Note

The fiscal impact of this bill is expressed as a range to  
accommodate the several approaches which have been considered in  
developing estimates. For fiscal year 1983, it is estimated that  
this legislation would cost between \$5,087,000 and \$9,267,000.

Statement of Fact

This amendment removes the one-year sunset on the adoption  
of the provisions of the Economic Recovery Tax Act.
