22	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
23	12 MRSA §7001, sub-§25-A is enacted to read:
24 25 26 27	25-A. Open firearm season on deer. "Open firearm season on deer" means the time during which it is lawful to hunt deer with a firearm, including the special muzzle-loading season as described in section 7107.
28	Statement of Fact
29 30 31	The purpose of this bill is to clarify the meaning of "open firearm season on deer" which appears several times in the fish and wildlife statutes. This change will ensure

- that certain safety laws, such as the fluorescent orange clothing requirement, which were enacted to apply during "the open firearm season on deer" will remain in effect during the special muzzle-loading season. 1
