21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

22 23 MRSA, §1201, sub-§16-A, as enacted by PL 1967 c.  
23 440, is repealed.

24 Statement of Fact

25 The purpose of this legislation is to repeal the statu-  
26 tory requirement that a sign be constructed and maintained  
27 on Interstate 95 near the northbound Howland exit directing  
28 travelers to Route 6 and the Maritime Provinces. Since the  
29 completion of I-95 to Houlton, the provision in the law  
30 which requires a sign in this area can be confusing to tour-  
31 ists who may wish to go to the Maritimes via Houlton and has  
32 created sign problems along Interstate 95.
