25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32	The purpose of this legislation is to repeal the statutory requirement that a sign be constructed and maintained on Interstate 95 near the northbound Howland exit directing travelers to Route 6 and the Maritime Provinces. Since the completion of 1-95 to Houlton, the provision in the law which requires a sign in this area can be confusing to tourists who may wish to go to the Maritimes via Houlton and has created sign problems along Interstate 95.
