20 **RESOLVE, Reimbursing Certain Municipalities on**
21 **Account of Taxes Lost Due to the Veterans' Property**

24 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature
25 do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment
26 unless enacted as emergencies; and

27 Whereas, the Legislature provided funds in the amount
28 of \$36,000 for reimbursement of the municipalities for taxes
29 lost in tax year 1981 due to certain veterans' exemptions
30 pursuant to Public Law, 1981, chapter 133, section 5, and
31 chapter 214, section 7; and

32 Whereas, the total reimbursement due to municipalities
33 for tax year 1981 totals \$70,826; and

2 quired in order to totally satisfy reimbursement claims of
3 the municipalities involved.

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
