 Applications for examination shall be in writing on forms prescribed by the bureau, shall be notarized and shall be accompanied by the application fee of \$5 \$25.

Examination Examinations shall be given but at least once a year unless hardship can be proven to the satisfaction of the board at such times and places as the board shall determine. The grading and passing of applicants shall be exclusively the responsibility of the board.

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A \$25 fee shall accompany each application for examination and shall not be returnable. When an applicant is notified that he is eligible for a license following examination, he shall remit an additional \$15 to cover the annual license fee of \$15 before a license is issued.

The fee for an annual renewal license shall be \$15.

7 Statement of Fact

Licensing fees, upon which the Arborist Examining Board operates, have not increased since 1949. This bill will increase the annual arborist license cost from \$5 to \$15, and increases the board member's per diem allowance from \$20 to \$40. The bill also changes the license renewal term from 2 years to one year in order to eliminate the financial impact of biennial licensing on this very small operation.

This bill will increase the board's annual income from approximately \$1,000 to \$3,000.
