consisting of one Member from the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House to serve at his pleasure and one Member from the Senate appointed by the President of the Senate to serve at his pleasure. Two of the private citizen members shall be between the ages of 16- and . 21. At least 3 members shall be paid officials of public or nonprofit community level agencies who are actively engaged in drug abuse prevention or treatment in public or private nonprofit community agencies. Membership may also include, but not be limited to, representatives of professions such as law, law enforcement, medicine, pharmacy and teaching. Appointments to the council shall be made so to insure that at least 6 members shall be persons recovered from alcoholism, chronic intoxication, drug abuse or drug dependency, having evidenced a minimum of 3 years of sobriety or abstention from drug abuse. The chairman of each alcohol and drug abuse regional council shall be member, and his term shall be coterminous with his term as regional council chairman. The President of the Council on Alcoholism in Maine shall be a member of the council, and his term shall be coterminous with his term President of the National Council on Alcoholism in Maine.

Sec. 2. 22 MRSA $\S7108$, 4th \P , as enacted by PL 1973, c. 566, $\S1$, is amended to read:

Members shall be appointed for a term of 3 years, except that of the members first appointed, 5 3 shall be appointed for a term of 3 years, $5\ 3$ shall be appointed for a term of 2 years and $5\ 3$ shall be appointed for a term of one year, as designated by the Governor at the time of except that any member appointed to fill a appointment; vacancy occurring prior to the expiration of the term which his predecessor was appointed shall be appointed only for the remainder of such term; and except that members who Members of the current Legislature and who appointed by the President of the Senate or the Speaker of the House shall serve at their pleasure; and, except that members who are chairmen of regional councils or the President of the National Council on Alcoholism in Maine shall have terms coterminous with their terms as regional council chairmen or as President of the National Council on Alcoholism in Maine.
