

2 STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment authorizes the carrying out of a new agreement dated February 1, 1982, between the State of Maine and Coburn Land Trust which gives the State additional acreage on Moose River Island which had previously been excepted from the proposed land exchange. The amount of land which is 487 acres in the southwest corner of Attean Township, Somerset County, should be changed to 545.
