COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1743, L.D. 1732
Bill, "AN ACT to Create a Revolving Fund for Publications of
the Department of Conservation."

Amend the Bill in section 2 by inserting before the
last sentence the following:

The commissioner may fix the price at which United States
Geological Survey and other maps, charts and other publi-
cations may be sold or delivered, provided that these publi-
cations are specifically authorized for resale by the orig-
inating agency and are specifically concerned with informa-
tion on the state's natural resources.

Further amend the Bill in section 4, in the first para-
graph, 2nd sentence, by striking out the word "Moneys" and
inserting in its place the words 'Notwithstanding the 2nd
paragraph of this section, moneys'

This amendment retains authority currently given to the
Maine Geological Survey to charge for the sale of federal
documents under certain conditions. It also clarifies which
of the transitional provisions in the bill takes precedence
in cases when both apply.
