Statement of Fact

6 This resolve enables the Bureau of Public Lands to dis-7 pose of a tract of land which, by virtue of its diminutive 8 size, remote location and situation among other residential 9 properties, has little or no potential for public use. Fur-10 ther, it would enable the Bureau of Public Lands to trans-11 late neglected and unmanaged real property into revenue for 12 more appropriate land acquisition.

13 In accordance with established procedure, the Bureau of 14 Public Lands has queried other state agencies about the use 15 of this property. The response has been negative.

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The current assessed value of this property is \$4,720.
