Amend the Bill in subsection 2 in the first paragraph, 10 Amend the Bill in subsection 2 in the first paragraph, 11 10th line (first page, line 33 in L.D.) by striking out the 12 underlined words "this State" and inserting in their place 13 the following: 'Maine in an area designated by the Commis-14 sioner of Human Services as being medically underserved'

Further amend the bill in the 8th line before the statement of fact (page 2, line 14 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words "a community of Maine" and inserting in their place the underlined words 'Maine, in an area designated by the Commissioner of Human Services as being medically underserved,'

21 Further amend the Bill in the last line before the 22 statement of fact (page 2, line 21 in L.D.) by inserting 23 after the underlined word "<u>Maine</u>" the following: <u>in an</u> 24 area designated by the Commissioner of Human Services as 25 being medically underserved

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment makes the forgiveness clause in the bill apply only to those recipients who practice in underserved areas in the State as determined by the Commissioner of Human Services.
