13 14 15 16 17 18 19 20 21 22 23 24	Although the fiscal impact of this bill will be to a dedicated revenue account, there would be some future impact to the General Fund as follows: In an attempt to make this program self-supporting and eliminate any General Fund appropriation, the Legislature, in Public Law 1981, chapter 316, eliminated the forgiveness clause and established a dedicated revenue revolving fund to provide funds for future loans and to eliminate the need for the \$30,000 annual appropriation. By reinstating the forgiveness provision, it will result in less funds being repaid into this revolving fund and may result in the need for the State to continue appropriations to supplement this program.'
