9 10	Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:
11 12 13	'12 MRSA $\$424$, sub- $\$3$, last 1 , as repealed and replaced by PL 1981, c. 278, $\$5$, is amended by adding at the end the following:
14	Forest land which is eligible for inclusion within the spray
15	project and which has been accepted by the director may be
16	withdrawn from the spray program area prior to the end of
17	the 5-year period, provided that the withdrawal is made no
18	later than December 1st to be effective for the spray
19	project of the following year and that during the 5-year
20	period:
21	A. Changes in present law, regulation or Maine Forest
22	Service policy prohibit the forest land from being
23	treated with either biological or chemical insecti-
24	cides;
25 26	B. Natural disaster, such as forest fire or blowdown make insecticide treatment impractical; or
27 28 29	C. The director determines that withdrawal of the forest land furthers the legislative policies of this subchapter.
30	STATEMENT OF FACT
31	This amendment allows withdrawal of forest land from
32	the budworm spray program when natural disaster eliminates
33	the need for spraying or, in other circumstances, when the
34	director determines that the withdrawal will support the
