17 18 19	'35 MRSA §299, as amended by PL 1975, c. 392, §1, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:
20 21 22	For any particular hearing or series of hearings before the commission, the chairman may assign a commissioner, including the chairman, to attend.
23	STATEMENT OF FACT
24 25 26 27	This amendment allows the Chairman of the Public Utilities Commission to make certain that a commissioner is present at public hearings when that is particularly important.
