STATEMENT OF FACT

19 The purpose of this amendment is to require that all notices sent to a defendant in a small claims action be sent 20 by registered or certified mail. The committee amendment re-21 quires only that notice of the first hearing in the small 22 23 claims action be sent to the defendant by registered or cer-24 tified mail. In this way, the court will know whether or not the defendant has actually received notice of all 25 aspects of a small claims action that affect his rights and 26 27 interests
