17 18 19	AN ACT to Require the Recording of Certain Zoning Actions.
20	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
21	30 MRSA §4965 is enacted to read:
22	4965. Zoning actions required to be filed
23 24 25 26	1. Actions subject to filing. The following zoning actions are not effective until the filing requirements of this section have been completed by the person on whose behalf the zoning action was taken:
27 28	A. A special exception permit or conditional use permit; and
29	B. A variance.

1 2 3	2. Place for filing. The filing required by this section shall be made in the registry of deeds, where a deed of the land involved in the zoning action would be recorded.
4 5 6	3. Requirement. The filing required by this section shall be considered to be completed when all of the following acts have been performed:
7 8	A. Delivery, to the registrar of deeds, of a notice containing the following information:
9 10 11	(1) A description of the parcel involved sufficient to enable a proper entry to be made in an appropriate index;
12	(2) The name of the owner of the property;
13 14 15	(3) The name of the person on whose behalf the zoning action was made, if different from the owner;
16 17 18 19	(4) The name of the office and its address at which an inspection can be made of the zoning action and any plans or specifications referred to or incorporated in that action; and
20 21	(5) A general description of the effect of the zoning action.
22 23 24	A copy of all or a portion of the zoning action is suf- ficient if it contains the information required in subparagraphs (1) to (5); and
25	B. Payment to the registrar of a \$10 filing fee. to
26	Statement of Fact
27	A public record of variances and special permit granted

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by zoning boards of appeal or planning boards provides a

secure and permanent storage service for owners and purchasers of parcels of land. This bill requires that a

notice of that type of zoning action be filed in the registry of deeds before it becomes effective.

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
