19 **Falls to Withdraw from the Group Life Insurance Program**

22 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature
23 do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment
24 unless enacted as emergencies; and

25 Whereas, the Town of Mechanic Falls wishes to withdraw
26 from the group life insurance program of the Maine State
27 Retirement System; and

28 Whereas, withdrawal, if accomplished immediately, will
29 result in a substantial savings to the town and will allow
30 the town to take advantage of current premium quotations
31 from private insurers; and

32 Whereas, the terms of this Act will protect the inter-
33 ests of town employees and retirees; and
