17 **AN ACT to Provide that Administrative Employees of**
18 **School Superintendents' Offices be Recognized as**
19 **Members of the Maine State Retirement System.**

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

22 5 MRSA §1001, sub-§25 is amended to read:

23 25. Teacher. "Teacher" ~~shall mean~~ means any teacher,
24 principal, supervisor, school nurse, school dietitian,
25 school secretary ~~or~~, superintendent or other administrative
26 personnel employed in any public school, including teachers
27 in unorganized territory.

28 STATEMENT OF FACT

29 The purpose of this bill is to include all administra-
30 tive personnel employed in a school superintendent's office

1 as participants in the Maine State Retirement System. The
2 prior definition of "teacher" included some administrative
3 personnel, but excluded others from participation in the
4 Maine State Retirement System. This bill corrects that
5 problem.

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
