9 Amend the bill by inserting before the enacting clause 10 the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature
do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment
unless enacted as emergencies; and

14 Whereas, the Legislature last year inadvertently 15 imposed upon industrial and manufacturing facilities the 16 duty of obtaining a permit from the state electrical inspec-17 tor before performing any electrical work; and

18 Whereas, it is virtually impossible for such facilities 19 to comply with this requirement without continual and 20 serious interruptions in their operations; and

21 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these 22 facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Consti-23 tution of Maine and require the following legislation as 24 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public 25 peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

26 Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 27 and inserting in its place the following:

28 'Sec. 2. 32 MRSA §1102-B, sub-§5, ¶¶E and F are 29 enacted to read:
