COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1772, L.D. 1762, Bill,
"AN ACT to Clarify License Requirements for Municipal Work
under the Electrician's Law."

Amend the bill by inserting before the enacting clause
the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature
do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment
unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the Legislature last year inadvertently
imposed upon industrial and manufacturing facilities the
duty of obtaining a permit from the state electrical inspec-
tor before performing any electrical work; and

Whereas, it is virtually impossible for such facilities
to comply with this requirement without continual and
serious interruptions in their operations; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these
facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Consti-
tution of Maine and require the following legislation as
immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 2
and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. 32 MRSA §1102-B, sub-§5, ~~THE~~ and F are
enacted to read:

E. Any electrical equipment and work, including con-
struction, installation, operation, maintenance and
repair in or about industrial or manufacturing facili-
ties; and

2 F. Any electrical equipment and work, including con-
3 struction, installation, operation, maintenance and
4 repair in, on or about other properties, equipment or
5 buildings, residential or of any other kind, owned or
6 operated by a person engaged in industrial or manufac-
7 turing operations provided that the work is done under
8 the supervision of an electrical engineer or master
9 electrician in the employ of that person.'

10 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before
11 the statement of fact the following:

12 'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in
13 the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'

14 STATEMENT OF FACT

15 The purposes of this amendment are:

- 16 1. To add an emergency enactor to the bill; and
17 2. To make technical and grammatical corrections.
