The commissioner, with the approval of the state board, may grant the requested postponement provided that:
19 20 21	Sec. 2. 20 MRSA §1053, §9, as amended by PL 1979, c. 131, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:
22 23 24 25	If the postponement is granted for the conditions in paragraph B, subparagraphs (1) and (2), it shall be for 3 years. If the postponement is granted for the condition in paragraph B, subparagraph (3), it shall be for 4 years.

27 28 29	This amendment extends the waiver period for establishing a school lunch program from 3 to 4 years if its based on lack of need.
