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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1774, L.D. 1764, Bill,
"AN ACT Concerning Need Under the School Lunch Program."

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Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

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'Sec. 1. 20 MRSA §1053, sub-§9, first ¶, as amended by
PL 1979, c. 131, is repealed and the following enacted in
its place:

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An administrative unit, which had been authorized by the
commissioner to postpone the establishment of a National
School Lunch Program, may apply to the commissioner for a
renewal of the postponement. The commissioner, with the
approval of the state board, may grant the requested post-
ponement provided that:

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Sec. 2. 20 MRSA §1053, §9, as amended by PL 1979, c.
131, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph
to read:

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If the postponement is granted for the conditions in para-
graph B, subparagraphs (1) and (2), it shall be for 3 years.
If the postponement is granted for the condition in para-
graph B, subparagraph (3), it shall be for 4 years.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment extends the waiver period for establish-
ing a school lunch program from 3 to 4 years if its based on
lack of need.
