17 AN ACT to Establish a Uniform Hunting Season for
18 Raccoons.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

21 12 MRSA §7467 is enacted to read:

22 §7467. Raccoons

23 Any open season for hunting raccoons established by the
24 commissioner shall be of uniform duration throughout the
25 State.

26 STATEMENT OF FACT

27 The purpose of this bill is to provide for a uniform
28 hunting season on raccoons throughout the State. Presently,
29 York County and part of Cumberland County are given 5 fewer
30 hunting days than the rest of the State.
