## Statement of Fact

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This bill requires the approval of the Commissioner of Marine Resources before any discharge of pollutants to tidal waters may be given by the Department of Environmental Protection. This enables the Department of Marine Resources to evaluate the impact of the proposed discharge on marine organisms.
