21 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature
22 do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment
23 unless enacted as emergencies; and

24 Whereas, Burntland Pond in the lower part of Stonington
25 serves as the source of the municipal water supply; and

26 Whereas, it is extremely important that this important
27 resource be protected from pollution in order to insure the
28 purity of that water supply; and

29 Whereas, this protection must be provided as soon as
30 possible to insure that no pollution occurs; and
