17 **AN ACT to Clarify the Regulation of Sewer Districts.**
18

19 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

20 38 MRSA §1251, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 466, §13, is
21 amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

22 Those districts whose collection activities are limited
23 solely to collection performed pursuant to a contract with
24 one or more municipalities are exempt from the requirements
25 of this chapter. Those contracting municipalities shall
26 satisfy the requirements to the extent applicable.

27 STATEMENT OF FACT

28 The purpose of this bill is to exempt from regulation
29 under Title 38, chapter 12, those sewer districts which do
30 not set rates or have discretion in the placement of collec-

1 tors, but only operate collection systems under a contract
2 with the municipality where the system is located.

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
