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22 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature  
23 do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment  
24 unless enacted as emergencies; and

25 Whereas, the annual district tax on Wallagrass  
26 Plantation for its inclusion in the Maine Forestry District  
27 represents an undue burden on the inhabitants of that  
28 plantation; and

29 Whereas, tax certificates for the Maine Forestry Dis-  
30 trict must be filed on or before May 1st of each year; and

31 Whereas, unless this Act is enacted as an emergency, it  
32 will not be effective before the filing of the tax certifi-  
33 cates; and
