- (b) Each group self-insurer shall be annually assessed an amount equal to .1% of the total annual standard premium which would have been paid by all the members of self-insurer during the prior calendar year; payment to the association shall be no than April 15th following the close of that calendar year, except that the 1981 assessment payment shall be due 60 days after filing required in subparagraph (1) has been made with the superintendent. Regardof the size of the fund referred to in subparagraph (3) during its first 12 months of membership no group self-insurer may discount or reduce this .1% assessment;

Nothing in this section obligates the association to pay claims against a self-insurer which was not properly authorized to self-insure at the time those claims arose.

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this bill is to extend certain deadlines by which data must be submitted to the Bureau of Insurance by self-insurers. Some self-insurers will not be able to submit all necessary data by the present statutory deadlines.

The bill also provides that the Maine Self-Insurance Guarantee Association shall not be held liable for obligations of anyone not properly authorized to self-insure.
