Owners of private off-street parking may enter into agree-
ments with local or county law enforcement agencies for the
policing of stalls and spaces dedicated for handicapped per-
sons' vehicles, under which agreements unauthorized vehicles
shall be tagged.

This amendment establishes guidelines for providing
parking spaces designated for vehicles of handicapped per-
sons only. It also authorizes owners of private off-street
parking to enter into agreements with local or county law
enforcement agencies under which unauthorized vehicles using
handicapped-only spaces would be tagged.
