20 21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31	A governmental entity which self-insures against the obligations and liabilities imposed by this Act shall designate funds set aside to meet such obligations and liabilities as self-insurance funds. Any such governmental entity which self-insures under this Act shall maintain as part of its public records a written statement which shall include a provision setting forth the financial limits of liability assumed by the governmental entity, those limits to be no less than the limits imposed in this Act, and a provision setting forth the scope of the liability assumed by the governmental entity, that scope to be no less than that imposed in this Act.
