24 25 26 27 28	The comprehensive plan may include planning techniques such as, but not limited to, planned unit development, site plan approval, open space zoning, clustered development, conditional zoning, contract zoning and zoning to protect access to direct sunlight for solar energy use.
29	Sec. 2. 30 MRSA §4962, ¶I is enacted to read:

I. For the purpose of this subchapter, "conditional zoning" means the process by which property may be

1	rezoned to permit the use of a particular property sub-
2	ject to conditions not generally applicable to other
3	properties similarly zoned. "Contract zoning" means
4	the process by which the property owner, in considera-
5	tion of the rezoning of his property, agrees to the
6	imposition of certain conditions or restrictions not
7	imposed on other similarly zoned properties.
