AN ACT to Change the 30-day Notice concerning State Agency Liquor Stores.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
28 MRSA §153, sub-§1, 2nd ¶, 4th sentence, as repeal and replaced by PL 1975, c. 256, is amended to read:
Upon receipt of all applications for a special agency sto in a municipality, the State Liquor Commission shall noti the municipal officers of that municipality of the propose location of each applicant at least 30 10 days prior to the final selection of an applicant or applicants by the Statiquor Commission.

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this bill is to reduce the 30-day waiting period to a 10-day waiting period and should still provide an adequate period of time for a response from municipal authorities because of the additional 15-day appeal period required for all aggrieved applicants.
