21 22 23 24 25	Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no agent of officer of the State or of any department or agency material into a lease-purchase or other similar agreement whereby the State would become the ultimate owner of buildings or equipment for an amount exceeding \$1,000 in total
26 27 28	without specific prior approval of the Legislature throug the usual budget procedure. The request for approval shall be submitted as a separate line item.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require legislative approval of lease-purchase or other similar agreements where the State becomes the ultimate owner of buildings or equipment valued at an amount exceeding \$1,000 in total.

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
