17 **AN ACT to Provide for the Appointment**
18 **of a Provisional County Treasurer.**

20 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature
21 do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment
22 unless enacted as emergencies; and

23 Whereas, there are at this time concurrent vacancies in
24 the offices of the Somerset County Treasurer and Deputy
25 Treasurer; and

26 Whereas, such vacancies cannot be filled pursuant to
27 Title 30, section 601 in sufficient time to ensure the
28 timely payment of salaries of Somerset County employees; and

29 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these
30 facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Consti-
31 tution of Maine and require the following legislation as
32 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public
33 peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 30 MRSA §651-A is enacted to read:

3 §651-A. Provisional Treasurer

4 In the event of concurrent vacancies in the offices of
5 county treasurer and deputy treasurer, the county commis-
6 sioners shall appoint a provisional treasurer who shall
7 serve until a treasurer is chosen and qualified in accor-
8 dance with section 601. The provisional treasurer shall
9 have all the authority granted to treasurers under this sub-
10 chapter and be subject to all requirements of this subchap-
11 ter.

12 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in
13 the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.

14 STATEMENT OF FACT

15 The purpose of this bill is set out in the preamble.
