STATEMENT OF FACT

14

This amendment clarifies that the Priority Social Ser-

15

vice Program may not be used to match Social Services Block

16

Grant funds, formerly the United States Social Security Act,

17

Title XX. The Congress, in creating the block grants, no

18

longer requires a state match for this program. The amend-

19

ment does not affect the ability of the Priority Social Ser-

20

vice Program to match the Federal Older Americans Act and

21

other appropriate federal funds for priority services

22

identified in the original legislation.
