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SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A"
to H.P. 1836, L.D. 1833, Bill, "AN ACT to Exempt Portions of
the Central Maine Air Quality Control Region from Petroleum
Liquids Transfer Vapor Recovery Requirements."

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Amend the Amendment in section 1 by striking out all of
paragraph A and inserting in its place the following:

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'A. This section shall be applicable in the Metropol-
itan Portland, Portland Peninsula and the Central Maine
Air Quality Control Regions of the State, except as
provided in paragraph C.'

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Further amend the Amendment by striking out all of
section 2 and inserting in its place the following:

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'Sec. 2. 38 MRSA §610, sub-§1, ¶C is enacted to read:

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C. Because the controls identified are not "reasonably
available control technology" for terminals in
Searsport, located in the Central Maine Air Quality
Control Region, this section shall not apply to
Searsport.'

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
