2	to assist in those search and rescue attempts. Each
3	person summoned shall be paid at a rate set by the com-

9	C. The commissioner may enter into written agreements

The purpose of this bill is to provide the Commissioner 30 31 of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife with statutory responsibil-32 ity involving search and rescue operations in the woodlands 33 and on the inland waters of the State.

34 The prohibited act included in the bill helps ensure 35 that those responsible for search and rescue operations are timely notification of incidents requiring immediate 36 given 37 search and rescue attention.

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
