	designed to allow the harvesting personal use, without a scallop li-

cense. Present law requires a person to hold a scallop li cense to harvest any amount of mahogany quahogs.

3 Although mahogany quahogs are generally harvested com-4 mercially by dredge in subtidal areas, these quahogs may occasionally become available for hand-harvesting after 5 6 washing up on beaches after severe storms. This bill permits hand-harvesting of mahogany quahogs for personal use. 7 It should be noted that harvesting of mahogany quahogs for 8 personal use would also be exempted from municipal shellfish 9 licensing requirements pursuant to Title 12, 10 section 6671, 11 Title 12, section 6601, subsection as 6 specifically 12 excludes mahogany quahogs from the definition of "shell-13 fish."
