The similar map shall show expressways, roads, highways and interchanges in the State, at a minimum, at the same level of detail as is shown in the most recent official transportation map distributed by the Department of Transportation. Not later than January 15, 1983, the Department of Transportation shall submit to the joint standing committee having jurisdiction over state government a report on the implementation of this paragraph, including, but not limited to:
26 27	(1) A comparison and evaluation of the private map and the most recent official map;
28 29 30	(2) A description and evaluation of the adequacy of circulation of the private map throughout the State; and
31 32	(3) Recommendations on continuing or modifying the authority contained in this paragraph.

34 35	This amendment requires continuation of at least the current level of detail of roads in any map considered a
