## 6 STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this resolve is to reimburse certain municipalities on account of taxes lost due to forest land being classified under the provisions of the Maine Tree Growth Tax Law, reimbursements being made in accordance with the provisions of the Revised Statutes, Title 36, section 578. The total cost of reimbursement to those municipalities listed in this resolve is \$464,914.53, with \$348,568.03 having been paid to those qualifying municipalities as of December 15, 1981. This amount does not include a reimbursement for the 60 municipalities which did not file their municipal valuation returns in time to be included in this resolve, or 18 municipalities which did not achieve the appropriate minimum assessment ratio described in Title 36, section 327.
