Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill establishes the municipal cost component for the unorganized territories for services rendered in fiscal year 1983. This bill also includes adjustments for fiscal years 1979, 1980 and 1981, as well as adjustments due to rounding of the mill rate, supplemental assessments, tax abatements and reserves for accounts receivable. The revised net requirement should reconcile the account to more properly reflect the necessary adjustment.
