18 19 20 21 22 23	No utility may be allowed to earn a return on investments in construction work in progress, unless the commission finds that the failure to allow such return will cause the utility severe financial difficulty which cannot be otherwise alleviated without materially increasing the cost of electricity to consumers.
24	STATEMENT OF FACT
25 26 27 28 29 30	This amendment prohibits inclusion of any return on construction work in progress, except in cases where the Public Utilities Commission finds that it would be necessary in order to avoid a substantial adverse financial effect on the utility which would increase the cost of electricity to consumers.
